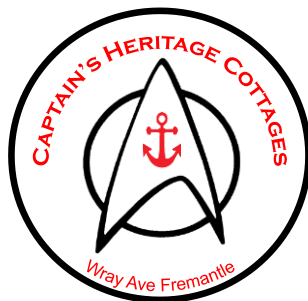

**Please Note:**

Fremantle Sailing Club Galley facilities will be open prior to the race on Saturday morning from 0730 for take-away rolls, sandwiches, hot and cold drinks. There will also be a breakfast special available on the day. There will be no alcoholic beverages available at this time. Berthing facilities may be available from Friday for all visiting boats. Please contact the FSC Harbour Master if you would like to leave your boat at FSC before or after the race.

## Supplementary Sailing Instructions

### 1. Rules

The race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions published in the Ocean Racing Western Australia Handbook 2018/19 and by these Supplementary Sailing Instructions. In the event of conflict, these Supplementary Sailing Instructions will prevail.

### 2. Marks

- 2.1. The Start Pin and Day Buoy will be Yellow Cylindrical Inflatable Buoys
- 2.2. The Port Bouvard "mark" and Yanchep "mark" will be GPS Waypoints as defined in Sailing Instruction 5.2 and Appendix WP to the Sailing Instructions

### 4. Radio Communication Procedure

Pre-race Radio Check – Fremantle Sailing Club Race Office will be open at 0830 hours Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> September for Radio Checks on VHF Channel 72 and HF 4146.

- VHF Channel 72 & 82 along with HF 4146 will be monitored for the duration of the race.
- All boats shall maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 72 and 16 whilst racing and positioned North of Coventry Reef
- All boats shall maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 82 and 16 whilst racing and positioned South of Coventry Reef

### 5. Position Reports

- 5.1. Scheduled position reports as specified in Sailing Instruction 18.4 will NOT be required
- 5.2. Mandatory Rounding Reports, Divisions 1, 2 and Double Handed will report to Race Control by radio immediately at the following points of the course
  - immediately after rounding the Port Bouvard Waypoint on Channel 82
  - when abeam of Cape Vlamingh on Channel 72
  - immediately after rounding the Yanchep Waypoint on Channel 72
  - when abeam of Hallbank on Channel 72

## 8. Entries – briefing and crew lists

8.1. There will be a compulsory race briefing for the 3 Ports Race on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> October at 1830 which must be attended by at least one of the Skipper, Navigator or 2IC from each entrant. All entries will be treated as provisional until the briefing and any entrant failing to send the required attendee to the Briefing will result in the competitors' entry being rejected without a refund.

8.2. Entries will be treated as provisional until the Organising Authority (OA) receives a complete and accurate Crew List in the required format using the ORWA Crew List template. The Crew List must be provided to the OA by no later than Wednesday 10 October 2018.

## 9. Protests

9.1. Sailing Instruction 16 is amended to read as follows:

9.1.1. Protests and requests for redress shall be delivered to a member of the Race Committee, or a Fremantle Sailing Club Flag Officer, within the time limit.

9.2. In the result of any protest being lodged, provisional results will be initially posted until the outcome of the protest has been determined and the results reposted accordingly.

Results will be announced 1830 Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> October at FSC.
