Amendment to Sailing Instructions #6

Sailing Instruction 16.3 is amended to read:

- 16.3 The starting line will be between a mast displaying an orange flag on the Committee Boat at the starboard end and a permanent club mark identified in the respective course for Inshore Races, or a red and yellow striped inflatable buoy for Windward Leeward and Valmadre Races.

Sailing Instruction 19.2 is amended to read:

- 19.2 The Finishing Line for IRC State Championship Windward Leeward races will be between a mast displaying a blue flag on the Committee Boat at the port end of the line and a red and yellow striped inflatable buoy at the starboard end of the line.

Sailing Instruction 20.1 is amended to read:

- 20.1 Inshore Racing – 3.0 hours
IRC State Championship Windward Leeward Racing – 90 minutes
Valmadre Racing – Any boat not finished before 1700hrs will be scored DNF (due to races being rated as category 6 where races can only be run in daylight hours)

- 25.3 For all Valmadre Races, boats are required to contact Fremantle Race Control on VHF 72 and inform them when rounding the second last mark of the course on the day.
